

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

The NYPD position of school crossing guard is parttime employment that comes with a personal sense of job satisfaction as you safeguard school children walking across busy intersections on their way to and from school. School crossing guards oversee and control traffic flow around schools in the morning, at lunch time, and at the end of the school day.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- NYC residency is required within 90 days of appointment.
- There are no formal education or experience requirements for this job, but all candidates must be able to speak English and be understood in English.

Additional note for School Crossing Guard candidates:


TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AGENTS

Traffic Enforcement Agents perform work of varying degrees of difficulty in the traffic enforcement area. When required, they testify at court, prepare required reports and may operate vehicles. There are several assignment levels offering promotional opportunities.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- NYC Residency is required within 90 days of appointment.
- Candidates must pass certain physical and medical requirements prior to appointment, including drug/alcohol screening and psychological assessment.
- Four-year high school diploma or its equivalent.
- Candidates must have a valid New York State driver license.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.

Entry into higher level positions, other than through promotional exams, depends on the applicant's prior training, education, experience and the job requirements for the position.



POLICE COMMUNICATIONS TECHNICIANS

Police Communications Technicians are assigned to the Department's Communications Section as 911 emergency operators; they serve as radio dispatchers of police resources and perform all other clerical and administrative duties related to the provision of emergency service. Police Communications Technicians are required to work shifts, including evenings or nights and/or Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. There is per shift pay as well as night shift pay.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Candidates must pass certain medical requirements prior to appointment, including a drug/alcohol screening and psychological assessment.
- Four-year high school diploma or its equivalent.
- One (1) year full time paid experience performing clerical duties; OR work that involves contact with the public and obtaining information; OR a total of 30 college credits; OR two (2) years of active military duty with an honorable discharge.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.



SCHOOL SAFETY AGENTS

School Safety Agents provide security and ensure the safety of students, faculty and visitors in New York City Public School buildings and surrounding premises by patrolling, operating scanning equipment, verifying identity, escorting visitors and ensuring that unauthorized personnel do not access school premises.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent.
- Candidates must meet certain physical and medical requirements prior to appointment, including drug/alcohol screening and psychological assessment. Candidates must be eligible to obtain Special Patrolman status upon appointment and become certified as a Special Patrolman within 3 months of appointment. This certification must be maintained for the duration of employment in this title.
- Candidates must be at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment.
 NYC Residency is required within 90 days of appointment.
- Candidates must be a U.S. Citizen and reside in New York City.

Additional Qualifications/Requirements for employment with the NYPD:

- Candidate must pass a character/background investigation prior to appointment.
- Candidate must pass a drug screening for certain positions.
- Candidate will have to pay a \$75 fee for fingerprinting as part of the investigation process.
