- 1. CCIP funds for 2003-4 as follows.
 - a. Five tenure-track lines--4 librarians and 1 CLT.
 - b. OTPS funds for 2003-4 as follows.
 - For books, online data bases, computers and software, reserve/AV digitalization, and security.
 - s70,000 of CCIP funds are dedicated to the chronic security problem.
 The Library Committee recommends that the \$20,000 shortfall (\$90,000 is needed) in the Security budget be supplemented by \$20,000 from the
 College Budget.
- Proposed library course, LIB 101 1credit 2 hours for 15 weeks, to be coordinated by
 Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs Kathleen Allen on an elective, experimental basis for
 one year (Fall 2004 and Spring 2005).
- Library faculty currently designing a Para-Professional Library Certificate course to be administered by QCC's Continuing Education program..
- The Library Committee recommends creating a capital improvement initiative for a new state-of-the-art library.
 - a. Library services and space are being continually encroached upon by non-library services. This situation is exacerbated when combined with the chronic security problems seriously hinder the Library's ability to service QCC's population effectively.
